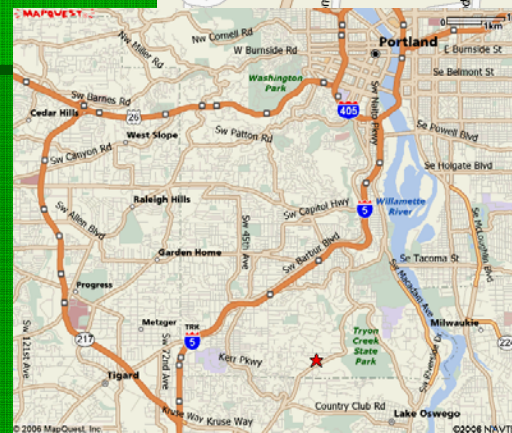
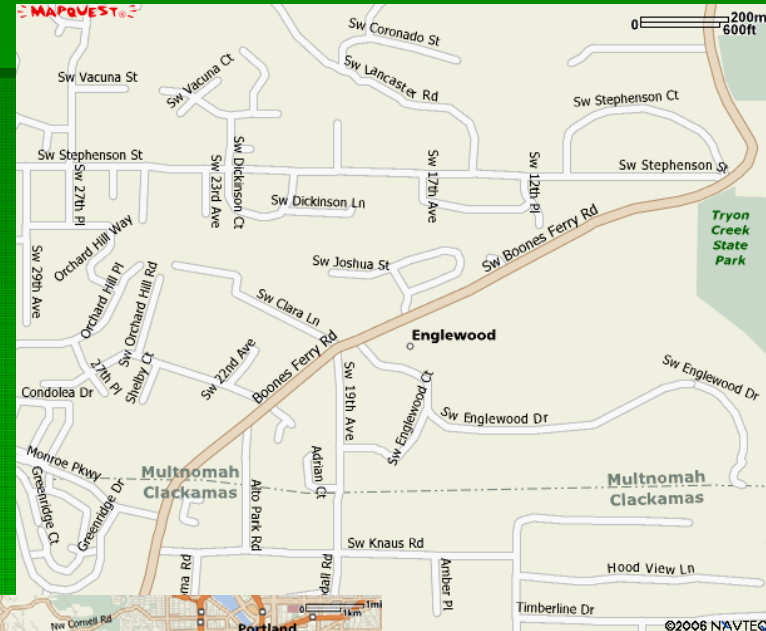

Area of Concern

- SW Boone's Ferry and Stephenson intersection
- SW Boone's Ferry Road from 18th to the Portland city line



The Problem: SW Boone's Ferry Road is not safe for pedestrians

- Posted speed is 40 mph but vehicle speeds exceed this and are not enforced
- No pedestrian infrastructure
- Side streets and driveways on average every 60 feet
- Limited sight distances

Excessive Speed

- A speed study has been conducted
- No enforcement of speed limits or pedestrian laws

- Tri-Met access
- School bus access
- Shopping plaza

The Solution: Reduce Speed Limit

- Supported by local residents
